The Fund is invested in equity (S&P 500 Index) and fixed income (Lehman Aggregate Bond Index) index funds managed by the Bank of New York and valued by the Fund at their published net asset value. Investment income and net gains (losses) on sales of securities and unrealized appreciation (depreciation) in fair value of investments are credited monthly to ICSF's account based on its pro rata participation in the Fund.
