2nd Grader, Christ the King School, the Bronx

Hailey Marte, an exceptional second grader at Christ the King School in the Bronx, dreams of becoming a teacher one day. At a very young age, she has already become a big advocate of a Catholic school education and thanks Inner-City Scholarship Fund for making it a reality.

Hailey wants sponsors to know, “You will make kids safe, happy, and very grateful if you help them go to Catholic school. They will learn so much, like I have at Christ the King.”

Hailey is indeed thriving at Christ the King, where she is an honors student who loves reading, solving math problems, and learning on her Chromebook computer. She particularly likes learning about God and her faith, and appreciates that her school is a safe and nurturing environment.

This is a fact that is not lost on her mother, Jenny Veras, who values the structure, academic discipline,

and accountability at the school. “I am so grateful for what the school is doing and for how it complements and supports how she was brought up.” She wants Hailey to grow up with the same set of morals and respect that she did, so that Hailey can be independent, successful, and a person of character. “I want her to know that she can be anything she wants to be.”

It has not been easy for Jenny, a single mother who is juggling a job as a teacher’s assistant and night classes to earn her college degree. Jenny says, “It’s a constant struggle to keep up with rent, bills and the cost of just living in New York City.” Inner-City exists to take some of that financial burden away. Hailey’s sponsors, Christine and Stephen A. Schwarzman, help her and her mother through the *Be A Student’s Friend* program. “Knowing people are willing to do this gives you a sense of how loving people can be,” says Jenny. “I’m very grateful and appreciative for the help they are providing us.”

Jon-Erik Fields

Senior, Cardinal Hayes High School, the Bronx

Jon-Erik's first day at Cardinal Hayes High School was a dream come true for him and his mother, because attending a Catholic school meant a bright future was within his reach.

When Jon-Erik first walked through the doors of Cardinal Hayes High School as a freshman, he was nervous. The building was massive and the environment so different from the public elementary school he attended in the East Tremont section of the Bronx. In addition to the dramatic change from one school to the next, Jon was the only member of his elementary school class to attend Cardinal Hayes. But it didn't take long for him to feel at home.

"It's like a brotherhood," says Jon-Erik, a 17 year-old senior. "You're not just a face in the crowd. At a Catholic high school, pretty much everyone knows you, and you'll always find a friend."

During his time at Cardinal Hayes, Jon-Erik has developed friendships, excelled academically, and has grown as an individual. Looking back over his four years at Hayes, he says he loved the teachers, students and staff, but it was the discipline, dress code, and academic rigor that he appreciated more. He believes it is this culture that helped

him progress from being a traditional Regents student to an honors student taking Advanced Placement classes during his final year. "I had to work really hard," he says. "Hayes has molded me into a more mature, dedicated individual."

Jon-Erik, who loves science and history, has a 93 grade point average. He hopes to become a scientist one day and has his college sights set on Villanova, Columbia and Boston University. "Hayes definitely helped make college a reality for me," he says.

Long before college applications, SATs, and becoming a member of the National Honor Society, Catholic high school was out of reach for his single mother, a hard-working nurse's aide. Enter Inner-City Scholarship Fund and his sponsors, Elliott and Adelle Bottom, who Jon-Erik credits for helping him make his academic and personal journey possible.

"Inner-City Scholarship Fund helps people who otherwise wouldn't be able to afford Catholic school," Jon-Erik says. "There are opportunities out there, there is help, but you have to find them and find people who believe in you. My mother and I are so blessed that Mr. and Mrs. Bottom believe in me".

Our Scholarships

BE A STUDENT S FRIEND matches Catholic school students in need of financial assistance with a sponsor who provides support. Sponsors can choose to get to know their student personally or remain anonymous and receive periodic updates from their students.

THE CARDINAL S SCHOLARSHIP & HIGH SCHOOL AWARD PROGRAMS provides tuition assistance to families who transfer their children from a public elementary school to a Catholic elementary school within the Archdiocese of New York. The amount awarded in each scholarship is based on individual family needs, as well as on the tuition of the desired school and is renewable through high school graduation.

EMERGENCY TUITION ASSISTANCE awards a one time grant to families experiencing unforeseen financial hardship. This program enables students to remain in their Catholic school, which is often the most stable environment they know during turbulent times.

MERIT BASED SCHOLARSHIPS AND GRANTS are donor designated awards that play a vital role in helping Catholic schools retain high achieving inner city students. Students receive awards based on their service to their community, academic excellence, and a number of other donor designated factors.

For Kelly Duffy and Valerie Sena, the numbers tell an important story.

Whether it is the fact that 99 percent of high school seniors in Catholic high school graduate, or that roughly 98 percent of those students are accepted to post-secondary education, or that it costs \$8,600 to educate a Catholic school student compared to \$20,000 in public schools. Kelly and Valerie know they are changing lives by helping to pay for a student's education through Inner-City Scholarship Fund.

"The stats don't lie," says Kelly, an accountant. "This is not an anomaly."

The two, who have been friends since they met as students at the University of Notre Dame, started volunteering for Inner-City's Job Opportunities Program (JOP) a few years ago and were impressed by the bright, respectful and kind Catholic school students. When they learned about Inner-City Scholarship Fund's *Be A Student's Friend* program, they wanted

to be a part of it, to help students get off on the right foot and be well-positioned for success in life.

First, they were able to share the cost of sponsoring one student. Over time, they were able to support two students, and eventually a company match helped them provide a third student with a high-quality Catholic education.

"We are helping in the way that we can," says Valerie, an advertising executive. "The students have the love and foundation of a supportive family, who know a Catholic school is the best choice for their child, but the financial requirement stands in the way. For us, taking away that obstacle is the best way to give back and help these kids."

"We have loved helping the kids, but we have been surprised at what this program has done for us," Valerie says. "Through our shared commitment, we have actually helped better each other."



The miracles within the walls.

Father Joseph Tierney

President, Cardinal Hayes High School, the Bronx

Most mornings at Cardinal Hayes High School start the same way, with Father Joseph Tierney presiding over the green marble foyer where “Hayesmen” must enter, greeting the boys with a hello, a handshake, and a warm welcome.

The building itself is impressive, with its stately brick edifice along the Grand Concourse in the South Bronx. Father Joe, as he is known to many, has been the president of Cardinal Hayes since 2005, affectionately referring to the school as the “Hayes House.”

Cardinal Hayes is much more than a welcoming place and safe haven. It is a Catholic college preparatory school whose mission is to help young men become moral leaders, respectful gentlemen and responsible citizens.

“The miracle is what goes on in this building,” Father Tierney says.

Hayes has graduated approximately 30,000 students since it first opened its doors in 1941—many of whom have distinguished themselves in the fields of business, labor, film, sport, and nonprofit work, to name a few. And its impressive legacy endures: 99 percent of Hayes students graduate and

virtually all of them go on to college—most to their top choices.

A hallmark of Catholic high school education, if you are a part of Hayes, you are a member of a family, Father Tierney notes. And this is a family that takes care of one another.

Cardinal Hayes is located in the poorest Congressional district in the United States. Almost all of the students are either Hispanic (65 percent) or African-American (32 percent). Families struggle to pay tuition, often sacrificing other necessities, such as meals every day. Despite these personal struggles, Hayes students organize food drives, collect toys around Christmas, and raise money for missionary work and recovery efforts from natural disasters. “They realize that the community they live in is in more need than they are themselves.”

“Compassion, generosity, discipline and faith are integral aspects of the Catholic school tradition,” Father Tierney says. The commitment an Inner-City donor makes to a student, a commitment with a lifelong impact, is not lost on these young men. Father Tierney makes sure of that.
