
For more than five decades, Inner-City has encouraged and challenged generations of students in New York, many economically challenged, to be leaders, responsible citizens, and contributors to this great city.

That's why when she received an acceptance letter from AMSU, she and her mother couldn't contain themselves.


"Thank you for this opportunity and this scholarship. If it wasn't for this scholarship, my mother couldn't afford to send me here. She is so happy that she has help."

A Principal's Guiding Principles

John Musto, a principal and educator in the Archdiocese of New York for 30 years, has taught a fair share of students during his tenure. He's learned that students excel when they are having fun and feel safe. You might call these his guiding principles.

"I truly believe it has to be fun in the classroom," Principal Musto says. "It's a safe place for a lot of kids."

When he arrived at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel 4 years ago after 26 years at St. Raymond High School for Boys, Principal Musto felt right at home. He understood the students, the staff, and the community: it was the right fit for him.

For many students, the best part of their day is in the classroom with caring teachers who are entirely dedicated to their students.

"Catholic schools do an exceptional job in terms of educating the whole person," he says. "It's truly a great family atmosphere."

That's why so many teachers and staff have been at the school for 20 and 30 years, he says. And it is why so many students succeed in school despite other challenges in their lives.

"These are wonderful kids, but they come from tough areas with a lot of struggles. Their parents sacrifice a lot to send them here."

Principal Musto also credits Inner-City Scholarship Fund for making the experience a reality for so many. Without the help, it would be financially impossible for many families.

"Inner-City does God's work."





A Sense of Service and Giving Back to the Community

For as far back as Diane O'Neill can trace, members of her family have gone to Catholic schools. The Upper Manhattan native, who graduated from Good Shepherd Elementary School, Academy of Mount St. Ursula, and Loyola University with a degree in accounting, figures that at least three or four generations have experienced a traditional Catholic education.

"We had the benefit of Catholic schools," she says. "We had such a great experience."

Diane credits the consistency of the curriculum, and believes it provided her with the foundations for life: confidence, determination, and an understanding that success comes when you work hard and apply yourself. Diane, who now works in finance for Mercer, a business of Marsh McLennan, says she had great teachers throughout her years in Catholic schools. It's part of the reason why she now supports Inner-City Scholarship Fund.

"We were taught this sense of service and giving back to the community," she says. "I'm able to contribute. I wouldn't have this career if I didn't have the education."

While New York City has changed, so too have the populations served by the schools in the Archdiocese of New York. But the mission has remained consistent over generations, Diane notes. She also understands that it has become increasingly difficult for people to attend Catholic or private school due to financial reasons, which is why she has been supporting Inner-City and sponsoring students since 2007.

"I had this impactful experience, and I wanted to share my support," she says. "It's a special opportunity to shepherd along the next generation."


