Scholar Guidelines

- **Must complete application each year to renew**
- **Report Cards are requested**
- **Positive conduct grade**
- **No more than 10 absences and 10 late arrivals**
- **Student correspondence to donors**
- **May be required to attend events**

Emergency Tuition Assistance (ETA)

For students whose families are experiencing any of the following within the past 12 months:

- A severe or terminal illness of an immediate family member
- Death of an immediate family member
- Loss of family home due to disaster
- Loss of family home due to eviction or immediate danger
- A temporary reduction in household income (job loss/reduction in hours)
- A change in marital status that will result in a change in household income

This is not renewable aid. Past year debts and tuition over 3 months in arrears will not be considered.



Application and Awarding Information

- Applications must be completed electronically through FACTS (there is a nominal fee for this application)
- Applicants are required to provide documentation regarding household size and income
- Award notices are sent electronically to the email address provided on the application (parents will need to log into their FACTS account to view the award details)
- Awards are visible to the schools as they are made (families will expect their billing to be adjusted within a few weeks of notification so please adjust billing as you become aware of the awards)
- All schools must log into their FACTS account to view awards details report (if you haven't set up access to view this report or have a staff change that needs new access, email Jennifer.Ward@archny.org)
- Inner-City only guarantees scholarship payments based on the months a student attends
- Exit forms are required any time an Inner-City Scholarship Fund student withdraws from the school
- Applicants are required to complete a renewal application annually



Note Regarding Nominations:

- **Nomination allocations can change from year to year.** We will let you know if we have funding available for you to nominate any new applicants and how many spots have been allocated to your school.
- **Rising 9th Graders.** Each year rising 9th graders who receive aid from Inner-City Scholarship Fund, Children's Scholarship Fund, and Archdiocesan Financial Aid are invited to apply for aid in high school. Therefore, these students **do not** require a scholarship nomination.





Exit Forms

Exit forms (found [HERE](#)) should be completed **IMMEDIATELY upon confirmation of student exit/transfer.**

Failure to complete exit forms in a timely manner can affect your school's current funding and future participation in our programs.





Appeals

If any parent has experienced a change in income and would like to appeal their award amount, they should send an email to: scholarshipteam@archny.org.

Appeals will be assessed on a case-by-case basis.
